



## Scriptures to pray over your students each day.

- **Pray for health:**

- **1 Peter 2:24 NIV** - *“by his wounds you have been healed.”*
- **Confession:** *Because of the wounds Jesus bore on his back, my children are healed, healthy, and whole.*

- **Pray for protection:**

- **Psalms 91:9-11 NLT** - *“If you make the Lord your refuge, if you make the Most High your shelter, no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your home. For he will order his angels to protect you wherever you go.”*
- **Confession:** *Because I trust in God, He has ordered angels to protect my children wherever they go.*

- **Pray for peace:**

- **Isaiah 54:13 NIV** - *“All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace.”*
- **Philippians 4:7 ESV** - *“And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”*
- **2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV** - *“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”*
- **Confession:** *My children recognize God’s voice and are free from fear, anxiety, and worry. His peace is a shield around their hearts and minds.*

- **Pray God’s plan:**

- **Jeremiah 29:11 NLT** - *“For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.*
- **Proverbs 22:6 NLT** - *“Direct your children onto the right path, and when they are older, they will not leave it.”*

- **Confession:** *God has good plans for my children, and they will walk in the path He has prepared for them all the days of their lives.*
  
- **Pray for wisdom:**
  - **Proverbs 9:10 NLT** - *“Fear of the Lord is the foundation of wisdom. Knowledge of the Holy One results in good judgment.”*
  - **Confession:** *My children are making wise choices as they learn to respect, honor, and worship God.*
  
- **Pray for their friendships:**
  - **Proverbs 12:26 NIV** - *“The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray.”*
  - **Proverbs 13:20 NLT** - *“Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble.”*
  - **Confession:** *God is bringing the right people into my children’s lives. They will find friends who encourage them to serve the Lord and do what is right.*
